

- Different aspects considered:
 - distinction between the public and the private;
 - importance systemic factors and institutions;
 - individual actors for public decision making;
 - political-administrative relations and driving forces of policy-making processes;
 - administrative integrity

SOME HINTS FROM THE DISCUSSIONS

- Need to address the human factor ever more
 - emotions, motivation, caring, interpersonal conflicts, the relations among colleagues, greed, ethics, good governance and virtue ethics
- Along with institution-building, structures and processes, attention to be given to the individuals who have to do it
 - leadership and management capacities
